



ENROLLMENT CONTRACT 2010-2011

NOTE: FOR 2010-2011, THE SCHOOL BUILDING WILL BE OPENED AT 7: 30, CLASSES WILL START AT 8:00 AND END AT 3:15 PM. WE WILL OFFER AFTER CARE TO 5:30PM. THIS COST IS NOT COVERED BY TUITION. TUITION WILL COVER COST FOR HOURS 7:30 AM TO 3:15PM.

In order for this contract to be valid, please initial beside each numbered item below. In making this application, we understand and certify:

_____1. We will participate in parent-teacher conferences, as needed or required, agree to attend the required Parent Seminars (two meetings each school year) and as many other school-related activities as practical.

_____2. The Undersigned shall pay the appropriate tuition and fees set forth in the 2010-2011 Tuition and Fee Schedule. Since Jackson Preparatory School hires teachers, purchases textbooks, and makes other financial commitments on a yearly basis determined largely by the strength of enrollment contracts, the Undersigned understand that the student(s) listed below are enrolled for the entire school year or such portion as may remain after the date of entrance, and that the Undersigned are obligated to pay all tuition and fees listed in the contract for the full academic year unless a written request for release is delivered on or before June 1, 2010, to the Jackson Preparatory School Admissions Office, in person at 130 Old Denmark Rd., Jackson, TN 38301 or via United States Postal Service. Requests for release shall be considered delivered only when received; Jackson Prep shall not be responsible for delays in delivery or lost mail. Request for release will be granted with loss of enrollment fee and a cancellation payment totaling \$400.00 (four hundred dollars).

_____3. AFTER JUNE 1, 2010, ALL TUITION AND FEES FOR THE ENTIRE YEAR BECOME PAYABLE FOR EVERY STUDENT LISTED BELOW WITHOUT EXCEPTION. ALL ENROLLMENT FEES ARE NON-REFUNDABLE.

_____4. The absence, withdrawal, or dismissal of any student after June 1, 2010, whether as a result of accident, sickness, disciplinary action, or otherwise, does not relieve the Undersigned of the responsibility for payment of the entire year's tuition and fees listed in this contract. In the event enrollment is terminated after June 1, 2010, and prior to payment in full of all tuition and fees due for the year, the balance is immediately due and payable unless an alternate payment plan is made in writing and signed by all parties to the contract.

_____5. In view of this obligation to pay tuition and fees, even in the event that enrollment is terminated, the Undersigned understands that the Tuition Guarantee Plan is strongly recommended to protect the annual commitment under the terms of this contract. The Tuition Guarantee Plan insures partial payment of non-delinquent tuition and fees (pre-paid or due) in the event of separation according to the terms of Tuition Guarantee Plan for any student who has attended Jackson Prep more than fourteen (14) consecutive calendar days after the student's first class day of attendance in the academic year.

_____6. If payment of tuition and fees is not made in accordance with this contract, Jackson Prep shall have the right in accordance with applicable law to refuse to admit the students to class, to refuse to allow the students to take end of first term and/or final examinations, and to withhold the transcript or other record of grades awarded until all financial obligations of the Undersigned due at that particular time are satisfied.

_____7. All students are required to meet the academic standards of Jackson Prep and to abide by all rules and regulations established by Jackson Prep, including those stated in the Jackson Prep Student/Parent Handbook, as may be amended from time to time. All students, parents and guardians are required to respect Jackson Prep's spiritual standards, to provide reasonable cooperation in the education process, and to avoid conduct on-campus or off-campus that may be considered detrimental to the best interest of Jackson Prep. A breach of these obligations on the part of any of the Undersigned or the below listed students shall constitute grounds for the dismissal of the student or students from Jackson Prep.

_____8. The Undersigned hereby irrevocably consent to and authorize the use and reproduction by Jackson preparatory School, or any authorized by Jackson Prep, of any and all photographs, the negatives and positives, and video and audio recordings, which the school may take or may have taken of any student(s) mentioned in this contract for any purpose whatsoever without compensation to the Undersigned or to the student(s). All negatives and positives, together with the prints and other reproductions, and other recordings shall constitute the school's property, solely and completely.

_____9. The Undersigned grant to Jackson Preparatory School the right to test any of the students listed below for drugs and alcohol using hair, blood, breath and/or urine, either on Jackson Prep's premises or at the offices of a testing agency of Jackson prep's choice.

_____10. The Undersigned understand that Jackson Prep has no accident or hospitalization insurance on the students enrolled and that obtaining such insurance protection, if desired, is the responsibility of the Undersigned alone. This includes various activities sponsored by Jackson Prep including field trips, class trips, athletic activities, and the use of athletic facilities owned or maintained by Jackson Prep.

_____11. Jackson Preparatory School may refuse students the right to attend classes and all school-related activities until the Undersigned have furnished all regulatory agency-mandated documentation, including, but not limited to, shot records and birth certificates.

_____12. The Undersigned represent that all the students listed below reside full-time in the home or homes or custodial parents or legal guardians. The Undersigned agree to report promptly in writing to Jackson Prep any change in status from the stated in this paragraph. Failure of any student to reside full-time with a parent or legal guardian shall be a breach of this contract on the part of the Undersigned and grounds for Jackson Prep to terminate the enrollment of the student or students.

_____13. The Undersigned represent to have full or joint custody for each and every one of the below listed students and that each and every one of the below named students resides at least part-time with the Undersigned. The Undersigned agrees to report promptly in writing to Jackson Prep any change in status from that stated in this paragraph. The Undersigned agree that in the event that the Undersigned shall lose custody of a student listed below or that a student shall cease to reside with the Undersigned at least part-time, this shall be a breach of contract on the part of the Undersigned and grounds for Jackson Prep to terminate the enrollment of the student.

_____14. **FIRST TIME ENROLLMENTS ONLY:** Any new student accepted in grade Pre K thru 12 will be on academic and behavioral probation for the first nine-week quarter. The student must maintain a passing grade in all academic areas and their behavior must be in compliance with the guidelines listed in the Student Handbook.

All textbooks, novels, and technology fees are included.

Students returning for the fourth year (and eligible siblings) will receive a \$500 discount from the tuition rate. (Limit 2 children due to multi student discount)

Multi-Student Family Discount:

The student in the highest grade pays full tuition. The second student's tuition is reduced by \$150. The third student's tuition is reduced by \$3,500; each additional student's tuition is reduced by \$3,500.

Registration Fee

A non-refundable registration must be paid with the submission of the enrollment contract. For an enrolling family with one student, the amount of the non-refundable registration fee is \$250 for one student, \$300 for two, and \$350 for three or more. Tuition accounts must be current and in good standing to re-enroll students.

Installment Plans for Tuition Payment

Monthly or Weekly Installment Plan: Payments may be made monthly or weekly via draft initiated with our banking institution (which bank). Monthly payments beginning June 1 will be the tuition amount above divided into twelve equal payments. Weekly payments beginning June 1 will be the tuition amount above divided into fifty-two equal payments. Any payments begun after June 1 will be prorated and the payments adjusted accordingly (i.e. If eleven months are remaining and a full year of tuition is payable, the tuition amount will be divided by eleven or if paying by the week, the tuition will be divided by the number of weeks remaining until May 31, 2011.

Single Payment Plan: All tuition and fees are due to Jackson Prep on or before June 1, 2010. There will be a discount of \$200 per student when payment is made by this date. If the single payment is not made by this date, the paying party will need to enroll in the monthly installment plan.

Tuition Guarantee Plan

Tuition insurance is highly recommended by Jackson Prep. It provides families with tuition contract protection in the event the family leaves Jackson prep prior to the end of the school year for any reason. Please initial beside your choice below.

_____ Yes, we wish to participate in the Tuition Guarantee Plan. The premium cost of coverage is due with the contract. The Tuition Guarantee Plan is premium \$250. This plan reduces your liability for unused tuition between 50% and 100%, depending on the cause for leaving Jackson Prep. I have received a copy of the plan.

We understand that no refund or cancellation of the yearly fees will be made by Jackson Prep for absence, withdrawal or dismissal before the end of the school year and herewith agree to assume full responsibility for the full annual tuition fees.
